Dear Mr. Parry:

We are pleased to present this letter summarizing the results of the Phase I update performed at the approximately 10-acre site, currently denoted as Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 225-0080-055, located north of Duckhorn Drive, in Sacramento, California. This work was prepared in accordance with our agreement dated January 20, 2006.

Lowney Associates performed a Phase I environmental site assessment, dated July 1, 2004, of the site. The purpose of this letter is to update environmental conditions of the site. We understand that the commercial development on the site is almost complete.

SCOPE OF WORK

Site Visit

To observe current site conditions, our representative, environmental scientist Jacob Zepeda, visited the site on January 31, 2006 and was accompanied by Mr. Jim Hansen, construction manager for Lusardi Construction Company. Lusardi Construction Company is the general contractor building the on-site commercial structures. At the time of the site visit, the subject property was developed with four, two-story, concrete tilt-up commercial buildings. The four on-site commercial structures were in the finishing stages of being developed. The new buildings were not occupied at the time of our site visit.

One self-contained, approximately 250-gallon above ground tank (AGT) with an attached portable temporary pump station, reported by Mr. Hanson as containing diesel, was observed near the site entrance in the landscape area adjacent to the recently paved parking lot. The diesel AGT was reportedly used for Lusardi's grading equipment. A few empty portable gasoline canisters and a large air compressor were also in this storage area of the site, adjacent to one of the Lusardi construction trailers.

Temporary overhead powerlines were observed along Duckhorn Drive at the southern side of the site. Numerous storage containers with construction materials for the painting and tiling of the building interiors, the installation of the windows, and construction materials for the concrete flatwork were observed along the west and southwest areas of the site.

The eastern half of the property was primarily vacant, with five small stockpiles consisting of gravel, grass, and dark clayey soils; four concrete storm drain pipelines and construction

materials, and a trash pile with concrete and rebar were stored in this area. A transformer was being installed during our site visit in this area on-site.

A larger stockpile and a trash bin were observed in the central area of the eastern side of the site. Approximately fifty feet wide by fifty feet long by approximately four feet tall, consisting of brown clay and some rounded gravels and grass, reportedly from the grading of the western side of the site. Landscape materials including trees and plants were stored adjacent to the recently paved areas in the central area of the site. The associated sewer, storm, and electrical underground utilities appeared to have been installed. The observed storm drain inlets were protected with fabric around the perimeter of the site and along the canal to the north.

Several construction vehicles were observed on-site in the areas of construction, including a few forklifts, dump trucks, concrete trucks; a street sweeper was parked along the south side near the storage containers.

The northwestern section of the site was used to store various construction materials, with five storage bins containing electrical supplies, carpentry supplies (wood, tiles, and air compressors), aluminum and glass products, steel reinforcement bar, and small amount of subdrain pipelines (4-inch diameter). Several plastic bags that appeared to be filled with household refuse, a pile of wood debris, one soil stockpile, and one baserock stockpile were also observed in the northwest corner of the site in the landscape and parking lot areas. The soil stockpile consisted of brown silty clays and was reported by Mr. Hansen to have originated from the site. One concrete wash-out pit lined with plastic was observed in the parking lot along the northern section of the site.

Agency Database Review

A regulatory agency database report was obtained and reviewed to help establish whether contamination incidents have been reported in the site vicinity. A list of the database sources reviewed, a detailed description of the sources, and a radius map indicating the location of the reported facilities relative to the project site are presented in Attachment A. The regulatory agency database report listed no sites found in the vicinity of the project site.

There were no reported nearby hazardous materials spills or releases with a potential to significantly impact the site. The potential for site impact was evaluated based on information in the database records regarding the type of release, current case status, and distance and direction from the site.

Agency File review

To obtain information on hazardous materials usage and storage since the July 2004 Phase I, we requested readily available information on-file at the City of Sacramento Building Department (SBD), Sacramento City Fire Department (SFD), and Sacramento County Environmental Health Department Hazardous Materials Division (SEHD) pertaining to the site north of Duckhorn Drive (APN 225-0080-055). Representatives from the SBD, SFD, and SEHD reported that they did not have any files for the site.

Conclusions

Based on our site observations and discussions with Venture Corporation, environmental conditions of the developed parcel of the Venture Commerce Center appear to be consistent with the July 1, 2004 Phase I environmental site assessment. The construction contractor's hazardous materials use at the site did not appear to present a significant concern, provided that these materials continue to be used in accordance with applicable regulations. Based on the information obtained during this survey and the results of the July 1, 2004 Phase I, the planned use appears compatible with the known on-site environmental conditions. No further work appears required at this time.

Limitations

This report was prepared for the sole use of the Venture Corporation in evaluating the environmental conditions at the site at the time of this study. We make no warranty, expressed or implied, except that our services have been performed in accordance with environmental principles generally accepted at this time and location.

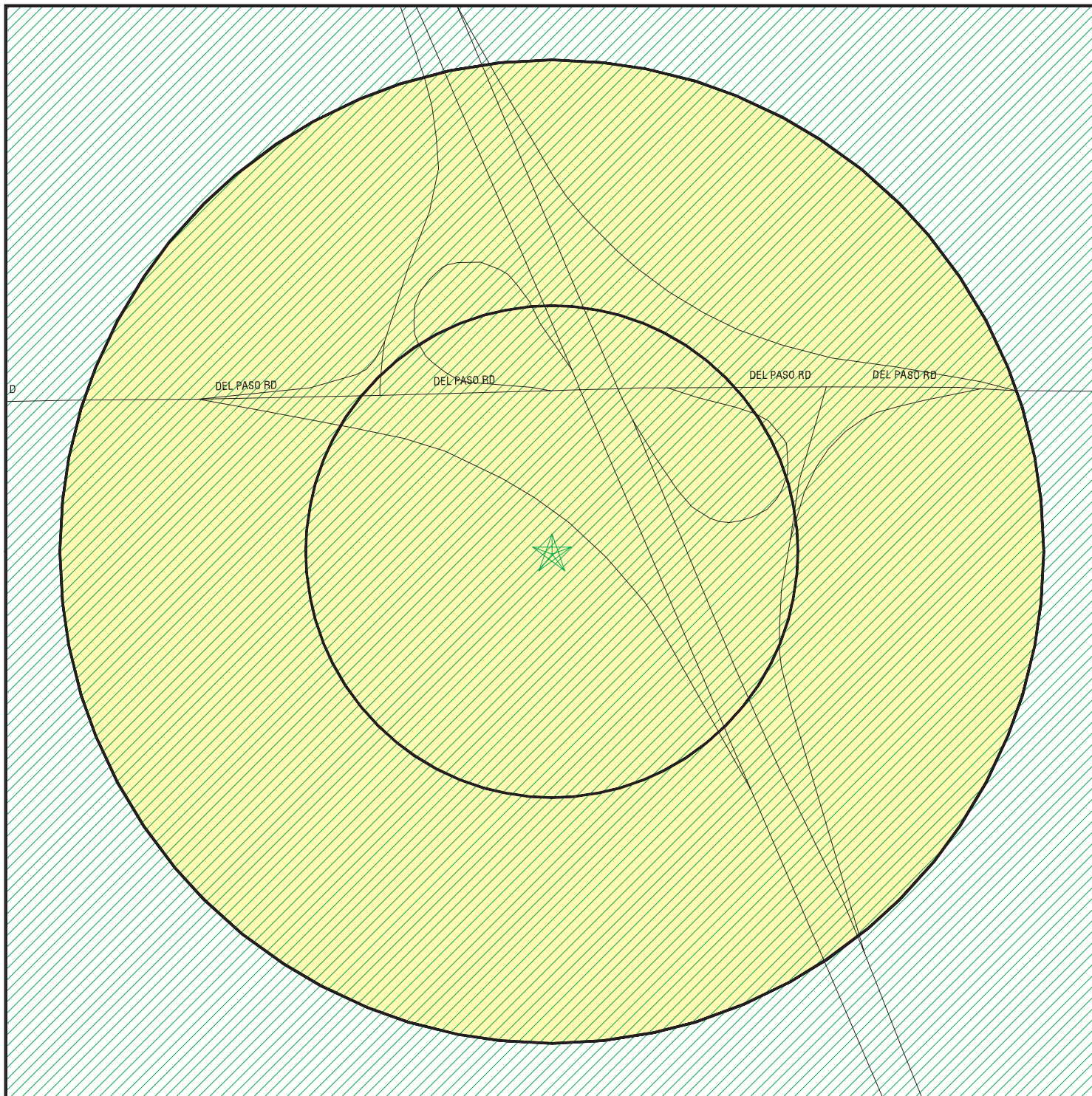

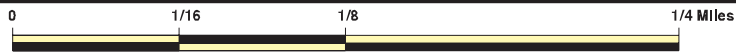
